Instructions

This is a fun activity to get students to interview and introduce one another to the rest of the class. In pairs or small groups, have students complete the template to write an introduction for another student. You can use the example below to get them started.

When they have written their introductions, have students take turns introducing their classmate to the rest of the class. You may wish to demonstrate how to use an exciting tone of voice like a circus ringleader. You may wish to instruct the class as to how they should respond to the introductions, including cheering and applause.

You can use this activity in conjunction with the poster activity, you could even have the posters ready for presentation at the same time as the introductions are performed.
