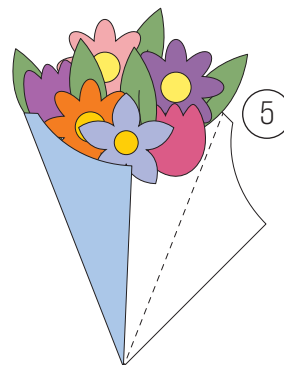
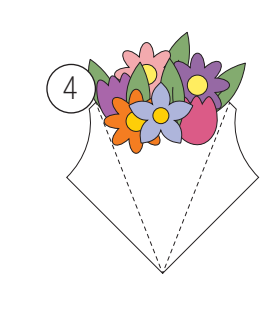
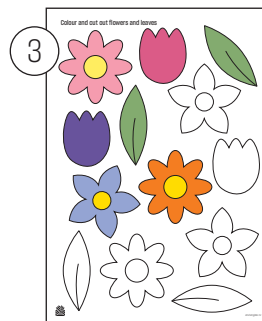
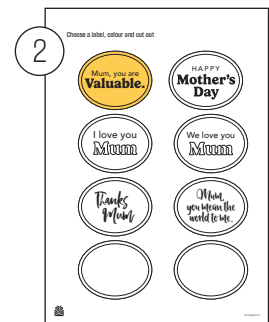
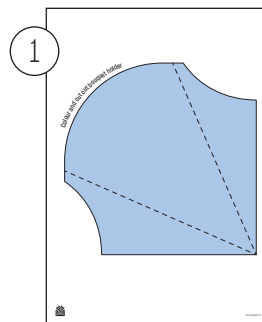


# Mother's Day Bouquet Craft Project

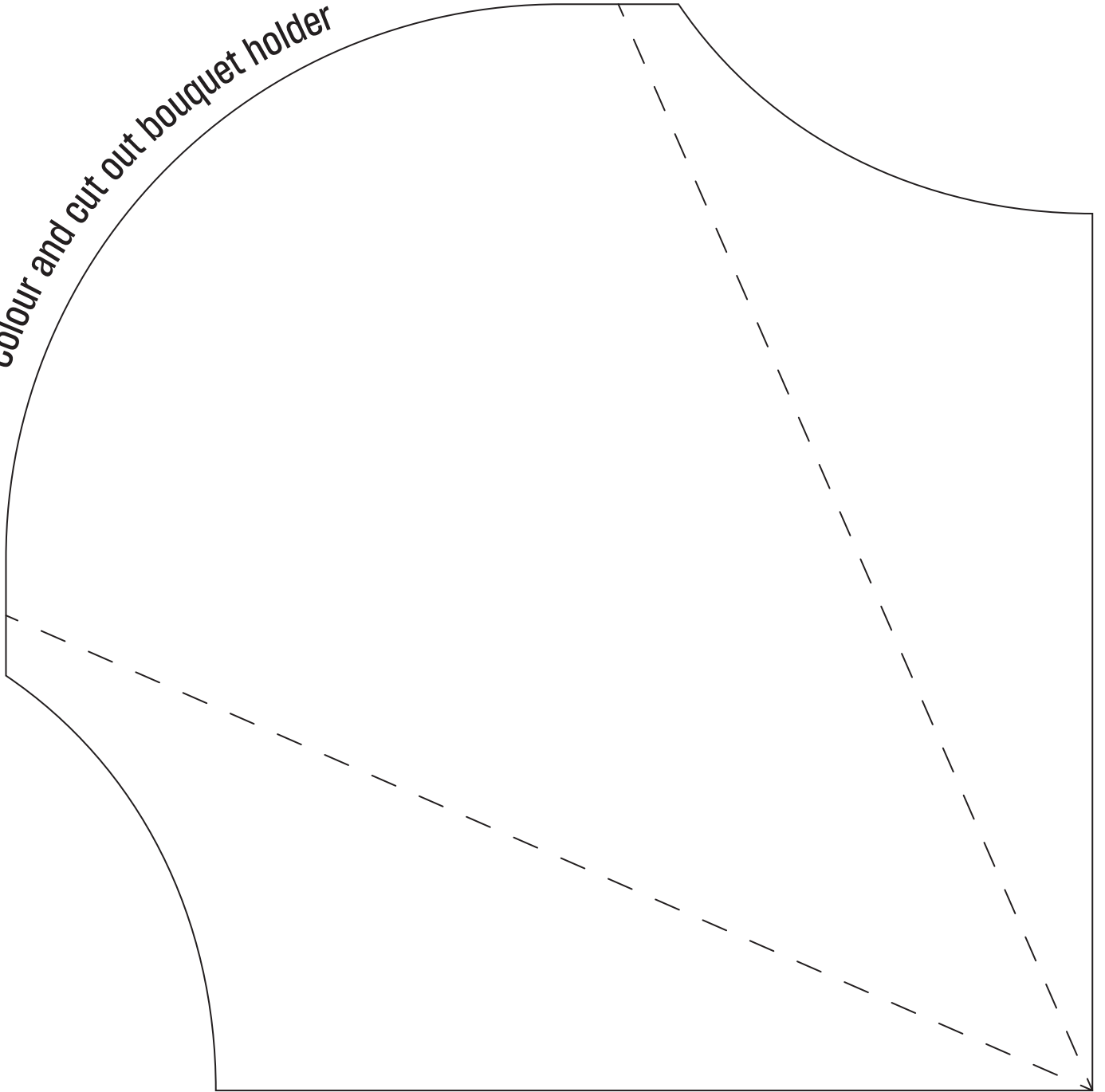
Make a beautiful bouquet for Mum this Mother's Day

## Here's what to do:

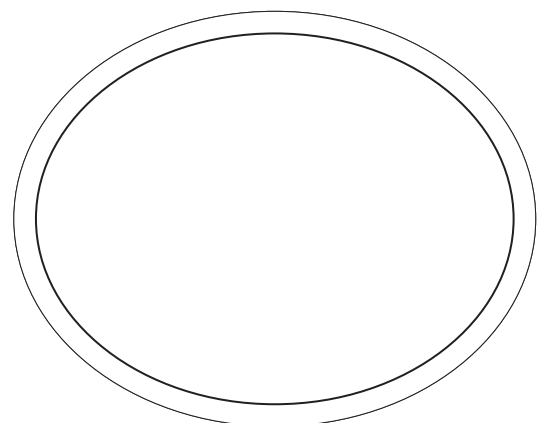
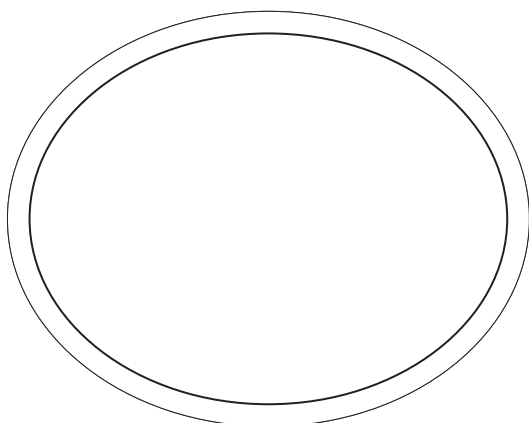
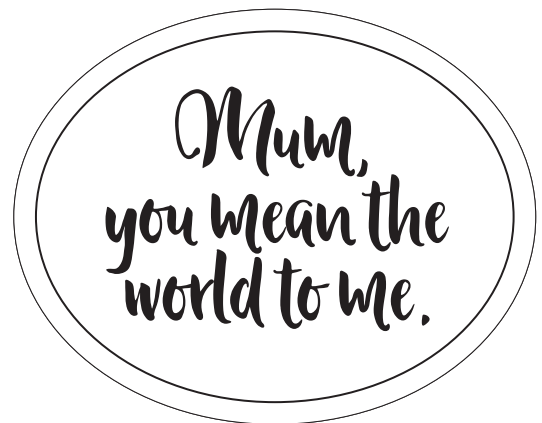
1. Colour and cut out bouquet holder, then fold along the dotted line.
2. Choose a label, colour and cut this out.
3. Colour in flowers and leaves and then cut out. Note: you might not need all the flowers or you could print extra pages of the flowers and just use one type of flower eg make a bouquet of tulips.
4. Arrange the flowers in the centre of the bouquet holder keeping them between the folds. The flowers can be placed over the top edge of the bouquet holder. Once the flowers are arranged you can stick them down. When sticking them down, leave some of the flower petals free from glue so that it give the bouquet more dimension.
5. Fold in the sides of the bouquet holder and stick the label in the middle so that it holds the bouquet holder shut.
6. Optional extras can be added such as glitter, a note to Mum in your own words, decorations to the bouquet holder. Have fun with exploring your own ideas.
