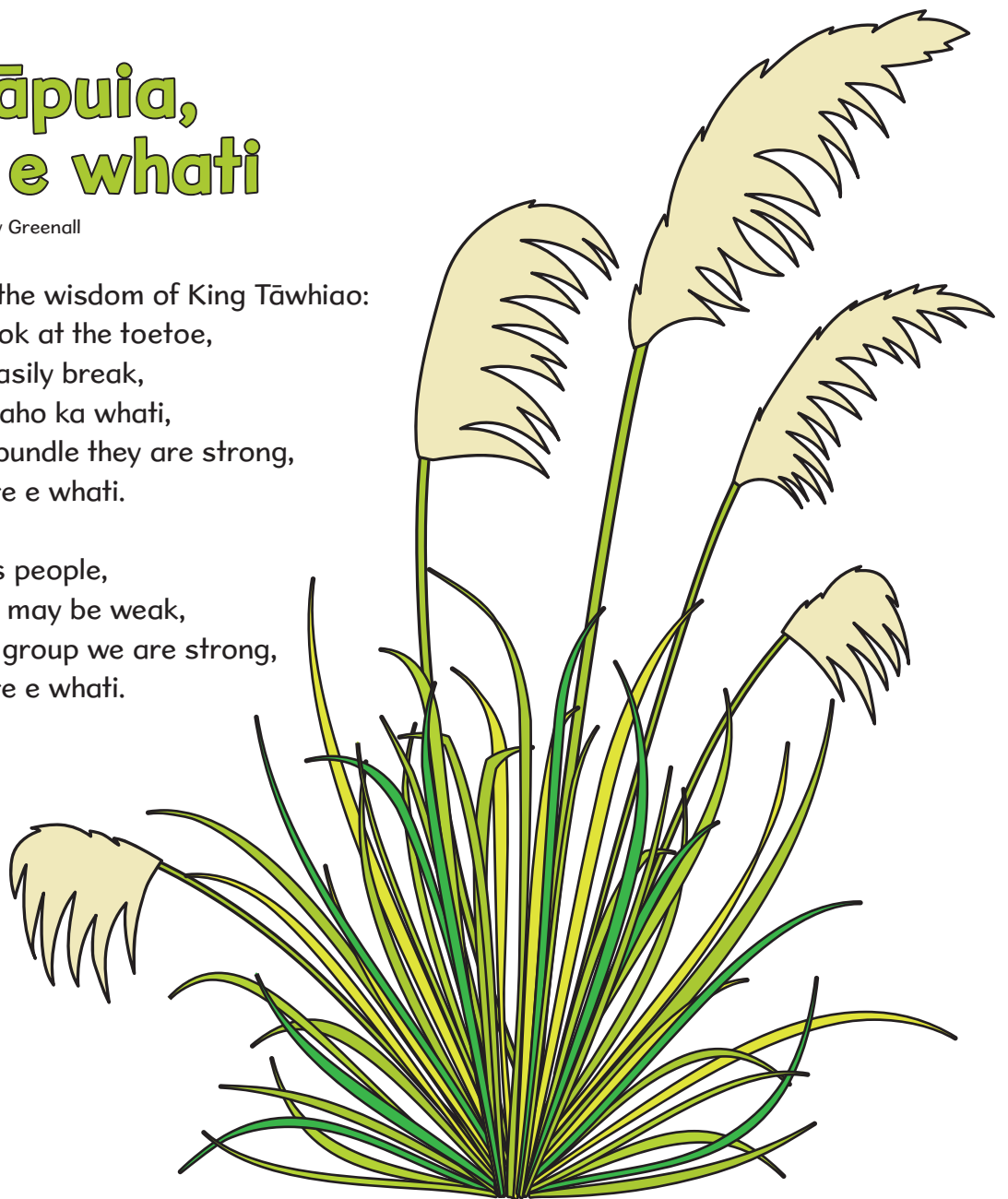


# Ki te kāpuia, e kore e whati
